This funding will be used to


- Increase the percentage of students achieving in the Upper Two Bands of Year 3 Reading from 52% in 2015 and 62% in 2016 to 70% in 2017.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving in the Upper Two Bands for Reading in Year 5 from 38% in 2015 and 32% in 2016 to 45% in 2017.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving in the Upper Two Bands of Year 3 Writing from 33% in 2015 and 38% in 2016 to 45% in 2017.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving in the upper Two Bands of Year 5 Writing from 15% in 2015 and 16% in 2016 to 20% in 2017.
- Increase the number of As and Bs achieved across all year levels, through development of a deep knowledge of the standards based Australian Curriculum

Our initiatives include


- **Consistency** – ensuring consistency of teaching and learning across Northgate State School through further embedding teaching practices outlined in our school's Pedagogical Framework.
- **Coaching** – utilise coaching and feedback expanding our understanding of the teaching of writing and reciprocity with the teaching of reading.
- **Collaboration** – maintaining whole school responsibility for every student by utilizing data for rigorous conversations, to enable good first teaching and classroom practices through to case management and early intervention with intensive instruction.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

Capability Building of staff:	
• Continue work with school mentor, John Fleming. Provide TRS each term, for every teacher, to enable individualised professional coaching, feedback for refinement of teaching practices.	\$24 000
• Provide TRS to enable teams of teachers/leaders to engage in collaborative data inquiry, action learning, classroom visits and professional conversations, with a focus on our 2017 explicit improvement agenda.	\$30 000
• Maintain a focus on the reciprocity between Reading and Writing : Continue to develop the capabilities and understandings of teaching and support staff, through coaching and mentoring, professional development, for quality first teaching through to case management and intensive support of students	\$20 516
• Purchase of appropriate resources the 2017 Explicit Improvement Agenda of Writing	
• As a NAPLANonline trial school in 2017, purchase additional hardware, software, and TRS days to support student and staff knowledge and skill development, linked to this initiative.	\$15 000
• Employ a speech language pathologist 1 day per week to assess all Prep students and teacher-referred students in Years 1 and 2, develop structured oral language programs for implementation teacher aides, train teacher aides and parents and monitor student progress	\$17 260
• Implement Early Start to track student numeracy competency in Prep	\$ 5 000
