Under this agreement for 2021 Northgate State School will receive

\$118 574

This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students receiving A-C across Year 1 – Year 6 in English.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving in the U2B for Year 5 Writing.
- Provide early intervention for Prep Students with increased focussed phonemic teaching to support a strong literacy foundation.

Our initiatives include

- Instructional Coaching: All staff engaging with instructional peer coaching and goal setting to support continued teaching expertise growth (specifically related to the skill of writing).
- Collaboration: Curriculum, Reporting, Assessment and Pedagogy Collaboration and Moderation to ensure high quality, deep understanding of student learning outcomes
- Collegial Commitment: Colleagues are committed to ongoing observation and feedback processes that relate to specific goals that teachers are working on to develop their expert teaching knowledge.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

Coaching: Continue to work with Northgate State School mentor, John Flemming. 2 Visits per year including TRS for all staff to work with John Flemming on each visit.	\$14 000
ICT: Purchase 15 Student Ipad's to create a class set for student use throughout school	\$8 000
Capacity Building: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - TRS to release all classroom teachers for Coaching Session 2 times per term. - TRS to provide support for Observation and Feedback Process to support developing teachers capacity. (Focussed on growing students as confident and capable writers) 	\$20 000
Creative Centre: Contribute towards the school funded Creative Learning Space comprising of a visual arts and technologies hub.	\$42 074
Early Years: Employ a speech language pathologist to work 1 additional day per week to assess all Prep students and teacher referred students in Years 1-2, develop structured oral language programs for implementation teacher aides, train teacher aides and parents and monitor student progress.	\$20 000
Early Years: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Development of strong community partnerships between Early Years providers and the school community, including support for transition days to Prep in 2021 -Employ an additional Early Years Prep Teacher to create an additional Prep Class to support early intervention (an additional .1 required) 	\$2 500 \$12 000
