Under this agreement for 2020 Northgate State School will receive

\$111 776

This funding will be used to

- Provide targeted support to Year 2 intervention in the area of reading and writing to decrease the students receiving a C or lower in English (Currently 49%, moving to 35%).
- Provide targeted support to improve the percentage of Year 5 students receiving A's and B's in English from 42% to 60%
- Provide targeted support to Year 5 Students, 55% or more students achieving in U2B for Naplan Writing.
- Increase literacy intervention support to SWD across Years 3-6, improve reading PM and Comprehension levels for SWD.

Our initiatives include

- Instructional Coaching: Teaching staff to engage with instructional peer coaching and goal setting to support continued teaching expertise growth.
- Collaboration: Curriculum, Reporting, Assessment and Pedagogy Collaboration and Moderation to ensure high quality, deep understanding of student learning outcomes
- Community Engagement: Developing strong Early Years Partnerships and Early Literacy Programs that enable all young children to have a strong start to schooling

Capability Building of Staff	
Coaching: Continue to work with Northgate State School mentor, John Flemming. 4 visits per year including TRS for all staff to work with John Flemming on each visit.	\$28 000
ICT: Purchase 15 Student Laptops for Year 6 Year Level to provide a class set for Year 6	\$20 000
Literacy intervention: -Purchase high interest low level readers for literacy intervention. -Purchase additional 15 hours per week teacher aide time to support literacy intervention. -Professional development for teachers (Writing Priority Area, 6 Traits of Writing Resources) -TRS to release all classroom teachers for Coaching.	\$33 016
Early Years: Professional development of early years staff in Phonological Awareness training and purchasing of resources	\$2 000
Early Years: Employ a speech language pathologist to work 1 additional day per week to assess all Prep students and teacher referred students in Years 1-2, develop structured oral language programs for implementation teacher aides, train teacher aides and parents and monitor student progress.	\$26 260
Early Years: Development of strong community partnerships between Early Years providers and the school community, including support for transition days to Prep in 2021	\$2 500
